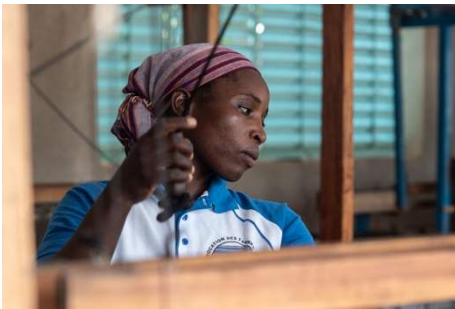

This order involved the production of a new weaving pattern that contributed to artisans learning process. Induction have been completed by technicians to give to artisans (6 men) a perfect understanding of the instructions.

This order consisted of 161,66 meters of Faso Danfani in 2 custom patterns for Lukhanyo Mdingi Collection 2022. Faso Danfani is the National fabric of Burkina Faso and a source of pride for Burkinabè people. In 2019 it earned a protected status from the government.
